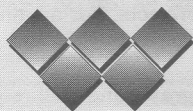

Creating and Editing Buttons

Several new button styles are now available with HyperStudio 3.1. For instance, "paint" your button into any shaped area. Great for those geography stacks!



Or use icons from any icon file or HyperStudio's built-in library. Make your button highlight when it's clicked on. Even use the lasso tool to define your button's shape! By the way, **buttons can be edited too!**

New Button Actions

New Button Actions add features to buttons which normally are not available in HyperStudio's main program.

New Button Actions are selected during the creation of a new button from a scrolling list. HyperStudio 3.1 comes with a number of very useful NBAs such as automatically scrolling text fields, dialing a phone, sorting cards, and many more.

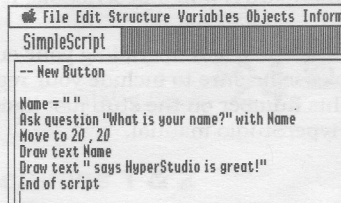
Improved Video Support

The use of both laserdisc and of the Video Overlay Card with video cameras and other video sources has been greatly improved.

Transitions between cards with on-screen video is smooth and controlled, and laserdisc videos can even be added and edited at home when you're temporarily without a laserdisc player.

SimpleScript

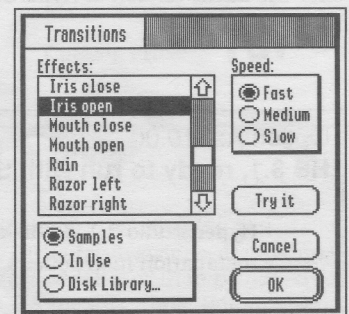
Scripting is the process of writing a sequenced order of commands which HyperStudio understands and executes. Commands range from making the speaker "beep," to hiding and showing objects, moving buttons to different locations, changing the color of the monitor's border, printing messages on the screen, drawing shapes, and more.



As the name implies, Simple Script is very easy to use. But don't let its simplicity fool you, Simple Script is a very powerful tool that even the most experienced users will enjoy.

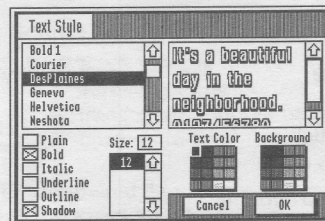
New Transitions

Visual effects while moving from one card to another (such as fading to black) are "transitions". HyperStudio 3.1 has many new transition choices when creating a button. A partial list of these include: iris open, iris close, barn door open, barn door close, rain, razor left, razor right, bow ties, fade to border color, and many more.



Viewable Text Styles

Now you can see what a text style looks like before actually making your selection. HyperStudio's new Text Style dialog contains a scrolling text field which displays the style before selection. A real time saver!



320 Mode Pictures

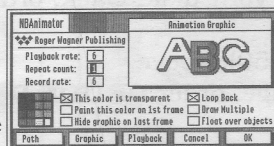
HyperStudio will now fully supports 320 and 640 mode pictures! You can even mix types in the same stack, and the transition from one mode to the other is virtually seamless.

Compressed Sound

Sounds used in stacks can take up a lot of memory. To overcome this, HyperStudio 3.1 uses the "ACE" compression method for compressing sounds. What this means to you is smaller amounts of memory needed for sounds and smaller stack sizes!

Easy Animation

Animator is a New Button Action which makes animation easy enough for a 1st grader use. Just select an image from the screen or a file on disk, move the image around with the mouse, and have it play back the image exactly as you recorded it!

Take Note:

You may already have two of the best Apple IIGs add-on devices for multimedia: **a TV and a VCR**. For just a couple of dollars you can easily connect both of these to your Apple IIGs.

On the back of your IIGs there is a round output-thing (technically speaking, a port) that has a picture of a TV monitor. Taking a wire with RCA-type jacks on both ends, plug one end into this port. The other end of the wire is plugged into the "video in" port of the VCR. Now, connect the VCR to the TV. (By the way, don't forget to turn them both on.)

Once the wire is connected on both ends, everything that you see on your IIGs monitor will be sent to the VCR and show up on the TV. Hit the record button on the VCR and you'll record it too!

With a second wire, you can easily connect the audio (sound) output of the computer by plugging the IIGs' headphone jack into the "audio in" port on the VCR. Now you have both video and audio!

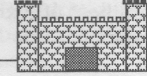
About Educational Stacks...

The Apple IIGs: What the Mac LC Should Have Been?

The Apple IIGs has features that are not currently available in any machine.

A review of the Mac LC in the December, 1990 issue of inCider magazine was subtitled "What the Apple IIGs Should Have Been?" The underlying idea was reasonable: If the Mac LC had been introduced in 1986, rather than the Apple IIGs, people would most likely have been fairly happy with this transition machine to the Mac. However, history does not accommodate "what if's," and at this point, one can legitimately ask, "Is the Apple IIGs what the Mac LC should have been?"

The Unexpected Factor

The unexpected factor today is the world of multimedia, and that the Apple IIGs is arguably the ideal multimedia (or hypermedia) machine. Regardless of what term you use, this environment will be more significant in the 90's than desktop publishing was in the 80's, particularly in the classroom.

The ideal multimedia machine should have good color graphics, excellent sound, and the ability to connect to laserdiscs, CD-ROM, and VCRs. It should be easy and intuitive to use, and as affordable as possible. You should be able to present your work, and easily record and transport it to share with others. The Apple IIGs has all this and more.

The Video Factor

Let's suppose a student creates a multimedia report, and then presents it to the class. With the Apple IIGs, a standard classroom monitor or TV can be used with no special hardware. Although a TV isn't great for displaying 80-column text screens, multimedia presentations with graphics, larger text, and video sequences from a laserdisc will look quite nice. On a Mac or PC, a projection system that can handle true color is likely to cost \$2000-\$3000, or more.

Laserdiscs, combined with a video overlay card, add a very attractive component, and allow anyone to create very exciting results. For the Apple IIGs, a school can buy a Video Overlay Card for about \$400. With the Mac LC (if a card were available), using the slot for a video card would preclude using the IIG card. Cards similar to the Video Overlay Card on other Mac models cost around \$2500. (By the way, services are now available that will convert your own videotapes to a laserdisc for \$200-\$300!)

On its way to that TV or monitor, the Apple IIGs video can be routed through any common VCR, recording both the audio and video portions of the presentation, so Mom and Dad can see what students did at school, and keep a permanent record of the moment. Presenters can go to conferences with just a video tape, without lugging tons of computer hardware. Macs and PCs require a special adapter (an "NTSC Converter"), and these can be an expensive addition.

VCR: The Printer of the 90's

You heard it here first: the VCR will be the printer of the 90's. How else to record sound, animation, graphics, video and more, and in a form that anyone can view (virtually all homes and schools now have VCRs). Once you're aware of what the Apple IIGs can do, hearing that another computer can't be recorded

with a VCR is like hearing it can't be attached to a printer. An article in the October 15, 1990 issue of Business Week discusses Apple's generation of computers AFTER the Mac: "At least two years off, Jaguar will include extensive video technology and the ability to connect to TVs and VCRs, Apple employees say." How great for Apple IIGs owners to know that they don't have to wait for the successor to the Mac. They can have all this now!

The Multimedia Environment

Schools that purchase Mac LC's, hoping for a color multimedia machine, will be surprised to discover the HyperCard on the Mac is only black and white. A limited ability to display single color graphics is available, but to just draw a line or two in color, you'll need an Apple IIGs with HyperCard or HyperStudio. Want to use the microphone on the LC? You'll have to leave HyperCard, run a separate program, and then go through some additional steps to incorporate the sound. On an Apple IIGs with HyperStudio, adding sound is easy and perfectly integrated into the overall environment.

Last of all is the working environment itself. Stackbuilding on the Apple IIGs is significantly easier. Thousands of schools are using the Apple IIGs for multimedia right now, and projects created entirely by 1st graders are by no means unusual. Home users of the Apple IIGs find it perfect for not only the kids, but fun for personal-interest uses from family trees to hobby-related projects. Through user groups, mail-order catalogs, and online services like America Online, CompuServe and GENie, there are already over 200 megabytes of existing hypermedia applications (stacks) of every imaginable kind—all for the Apple IIGs.

Apple IIGs: The Future Is Now

What does the future hold for the Apple IIGs? The Apple IIGs is not an outdated technology.
