An example. The following is an example of the support problems we will undoubtedly encounter through the use of funny DOS: Last year a bug was reported, whereby users who used Apple's DOS to delete files on a 13 sector Visicalc disk caused a disk trash situation. It subsequently turned out that the Visicalc version of DOS was incorrectly setting the VTOC field to 12 instead of 13 causing Apple's DOS to release the wrong sectors in the bit map which, in turn, caused severe loss of data on the disk in an apparently random fashion.
