

Page 2 - Booting the disk presents you with a crosshair, not logo. You are already in the draw mode. The arrow keys can be used for left and right movement.

Page 6 - Text: The Higher Text Generator by Ron and Darrel Aldrich is included in E-Z Draw 3.3. This permits you to use fonts (type styles) that are compatible with higher text. Some fonts are included on the E-Z Draw 3.3 disk. To edit existing font sets or create new fonts, it is necessary to purchase Higher Text, as E-Z Draw 3.3 includes the generator, but not the editor of Higher Text.

Page 7 - Second paragraph - Replace "!", with "▲", which stands for pressing and holding the "CTRL" (Control) key.

Many of the fonts included with E-Z draw do not have the capability of wide, expanded, upper case, lower case modes, or the ability to switch from small to large font. Experiment - you cannot hurt by trying.

If you get "garbage" when trying to type letters, this means the particular option you tried does not exist with that font.
(The above is explained again on Page 9).

Page 9 - Use Control-L instead of L to Load.

Please pay particular attention to the second paragraph of Page 10.

Page 12 - E-Z Draw 3.3 only includes graphics printing software for the Silentype and Trendcom printers. If you have another type of printer that will print graphics check with your local dealer for graphics dumping software for your brand of printer. Or, contact a store that specializes in graphics software, such as the Computer Station in Granite City, IL.

Page 12 - Says the printer is assumed to be in slot 1, when actually any slot should work. Printing maybe aborted on the SILENTYPE by pressing "CTRL C". Also, the intensity of the print will be requested for the SILENTYPE.

Page 15 - Color Commands.
Colors are now:

0 - Black1	4 - Black2
1 - Green	5 - Orange
2 - Violet	6 - Blue
3 - White1	7 - White2

We have added several small fonts which are not in the appendix.

It is beyond the scope and purpose of E-Z Draw 3.3 to do animation.
E-Z Draw 3.3 is a graphics editor only.
