


Loading Instructions:

Commodore C64™/128™

- Insert disk, label side up
- Turn disk drive and computer on
- The program will autorun on a C128
- For C64 - type: **Load ""*, 8, i,** and press **return**
- Plug joystick into port #1

Note: the presence of a cartridge may interfere with the loading process

Apple® IIE/IIC and compatibles (128K required)


- Insert disk, label side up
- Attach a joystick or mouse (optional) or use arrow keys and space bar
- The program will autorun when the computer is turned on

IBM PC® and compatibles (256K required)

- Insert disk, label side up
- Attach a joystick or Microsoft® compatible mouse (optional) or use arrow keys and space bar
- At **A>**, type **CBOW** and press **return**



- Shoot a colored box to select your adventure path
- Protect your friends from attack
- To score points shoot obstacles and enemy creatures
- For bonus points and next level, get friends safely through path



